

Whole class—students will review questions at the end of the video and discuss any questions that came up during the video. If necessary, the teacher may re-teach any portion of the video if the majority of the class needs it. A mini-lesson may be taught depending on the topic.

Work with the teacher in a smaller group. Complete practice problems with the teacher's guidance. When ready, move on to practicing on own using the resources available on BlendSpace.

Practice what was learned in the previous night's video using the resources on BlendSpace. Students may work in groups or individually, and they may complete their work on paper or on whiteboards. Students may (and should) skip around on the worksheets so that they are getting ample practice on each part of the concept. Students will continue working until they feel like they have a good grasp of the concept.

Students get the 5-question "quiz" and complete on their own (no notes/help) and then checks using answer key. Students will record their score on their tracker. If they get less than 4 out of 5 questions, review with teacher or keep practicing until student feels like they understand their mistakes. If they get 4 or 5 questions correct, move forward.

TASKS: When done with the lesson(s) for the day, students can work on the tasks for the unit found on BlendSpace. The tasks stretch students to apply the content learned throughout the unit. Each task is given a point value and students are given choice as to which tasks they complete. This is an ongoing assignment, and the tasks are not due until 2 days after the unit test.

OR

Instead of working on the tasks, students may work on the night's assignment. This should **only** be done if the tasks are done OR if we are not far enough in the unit for students to work on the tasks.
